



## California's Proposition 65

The State of California's Proposition 65, also known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, is state legislature that requires all products shipped into California that expose consumers in the state to a published list of carcinogens or reproductive toxins have a clear warning label affixed to the item and/or its packaging. This is not necessary if such chemicals are below established Safe Harbor Levels or are present in concentrations that pose no harm.

Decorating and printing inks used on Spector & Co. products that are decorated in Canada have been fully tested and do not contain chemicals at concentrations that would require a Proposition 65 warning label.

Safe Harbor Level limits have not been fully established by Proposition 65 for all materials used in Spector & Co.'s products, however we may be able to offer, upon request, certification of independently tested concentrations of specific chemicals for specific products.

In addition, customers may request that prior to shipment the following Proposition 65 warning be applied to their products:

This warning label will ensure compliance with California Proposition 65 regulatory requirements.
